MULTI-USE PATH

Paved pathways physically separated from the street.

— Beginner

BIKE LANE

Portions of these streets are reserved for bicycle use. Designated with a white stripe marked on the pavement.

BIKE ROUTE

Streets that are well-suited for bicyclists but do not have adequate width for bike lanes. Designated with green signs or way-finding signs.

Bicycle Suitability Ratings

The ratings include a review of traffic considerations such as volumes, street capacity, lane widths and speeds. The ratings are intended to provide bicyclists with an indication of rider comfort level.

Beginner Individuals with limited bicycling ability and some knowledge of safety rules and the responsibilities of bicyclists and motorists. Typically these are bike and pedestrian paths separate from roadways. These are also bike lanes or bike routes on residential streets with low traffic volumes and vehicle speeds.

Intermediate Individuals with some experience bicycling and knowledge of the rules and responsibilities of bicyclists and motorists. Typically these are collector streets with modest traffic volumes and 25-35 mile per hour speed limits.

Advanced Individuals capable of riding on roadways with high speeds and high traffic volumes and those familiar with safety rules and responsibilities of bicyclists and motorists. Typically these are roads with high traffic volumes and speeds over 40 miles per hour.
